

## **Profile for AMG Brochure**

Africa Missions For Global Charity (here-in-after referred to as AMG) is a full-fledged faith-based Not-for-profit International organization with the main aim of alleviating the plight of the underprivileged in Africa and around the world through appropriate community development and empowerment initiatives in line with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

### **Vision**

To be a leading organization for global charity.

### **Mission**

To Reach, Restore and Empower (R2E) Humanity.

### **Ambition**

To touch and impact over 100 million lives globally through community specific social intervention programs, focusing on education, health, clean water, empowerment, sustainable energy sources, feeding, clothing, emergency response and mission support. The target is to cover Africa in 10 years, while simultaneously extending its reach to other parts of the world.

### **Mandate**

The Vision and Mission of AMG are derived from its mandate encapsulated in Matthew 25: 35 – 40: “for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me...”

Following the mandate, AMG has a constituted board of trustees, and a management team with good corporate governance and values. The Visionaire and Founder is Pastor (Mrs.) Folu Adeboye and the Board of Trustees is Chaired by Pastor Brown Oyitso. The organisation has Pastor E.A. Adeboye as a Life Patron and Mrs. Eyono Fatayi-Williams as its Executive Director/General Secretary.

AMG operates through a regional structure comprising 4 regions namely, Africa, the Americas, Europe and the United Kingdom with 27 chapters spread across these 4 regions through which its various projects and initiatives have been executed in over 20 countries across Africa. The headquarters of Africa Missions Global is in Nigeria.

Considering the importance of youth and the need for succession and continuity, the youth wing of Africa Missions Global called ‘The Harvesters’ was birthed. The Harvesters is made up of students and young professionals who have a passion for charitable causes. They are committed to the liberation of Africa through youth centric initiatives using the tested AMG strategy of love, compassion and care. They will ensure that the work of AMG transcends generations to touch all parts of the world.

The Social Intervention Programs of AMG cut across 8 (SDGs 1-7, & 17) of the 17 SDGs with plans underway to touch on SDGs 11 and 13 as part of the new initiatives planned for implementation in the next phase of its development plan.

### **SDG 1 – No Poverty**

18 empowerment programs have been executed with starter packs provided for the beneficiaries of these programs. Over 1,000 people have so far been impacted and to ensure sustainability, 5 vocational centers have been built in 5 countries in Africa. These centres continue to train and empower people for the enhancement of their lives and the common good of humanity.

### **SDG 2 – Zero Hunger**

Through AMG's total schooling programs, feeding has been provided for over 1,000 children to date as hunger is identified as one of the reasons why children drop out of school or fare poorly in school.

### **SDG 3 – Good Health and Well Being**

One maternity center has been built and another is in progress to support maternal health. Two health centres have also been built and equipped to promote good health and well-being in rural communities as well as several medical outreaches which have impacted well over 10,000 people.

#### SDG 4 – **Quality Education**

The Provision of Quality Education is one of the strongest areas of operation. AMG has built, equipped and staffed 9 primary and secondary schools in 5 countries in mostly rural Africa and also set up schools or provided access to education for children in 5 other countries in Africa. This combined effort has facilitated the graduation of well over 5,000 children at primary and secondary levels. AMG has also provided scholarships for some of the children to polytechnics and universities.

- ✓ **Redeemer’s Basic Boarding School, Koma Hills, Adamawa State, Nigeria** – A full boarding primary and secondary school in the hilly regions of North East Nigeria. When Mrs Adeboye intervened in this rural community in the late 1990s, they were isolated from society and wore no clothes. Today, through the school in Koma Hills, this community is now well known with children from the school coming tops in educational achievements in Adamawa State, North East Nigeria. The school is equipped with classroom blocks, hostels, libraries, dining facilities, boreholes, and solar energy for the provision of clean energy.
